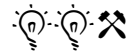

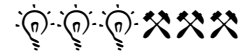

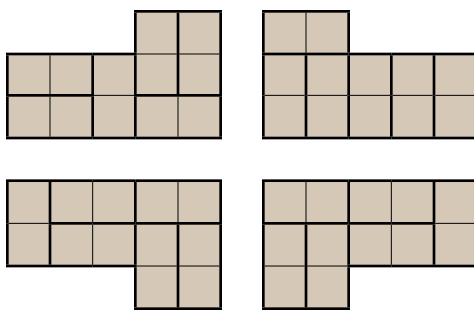
Building Good Habitats



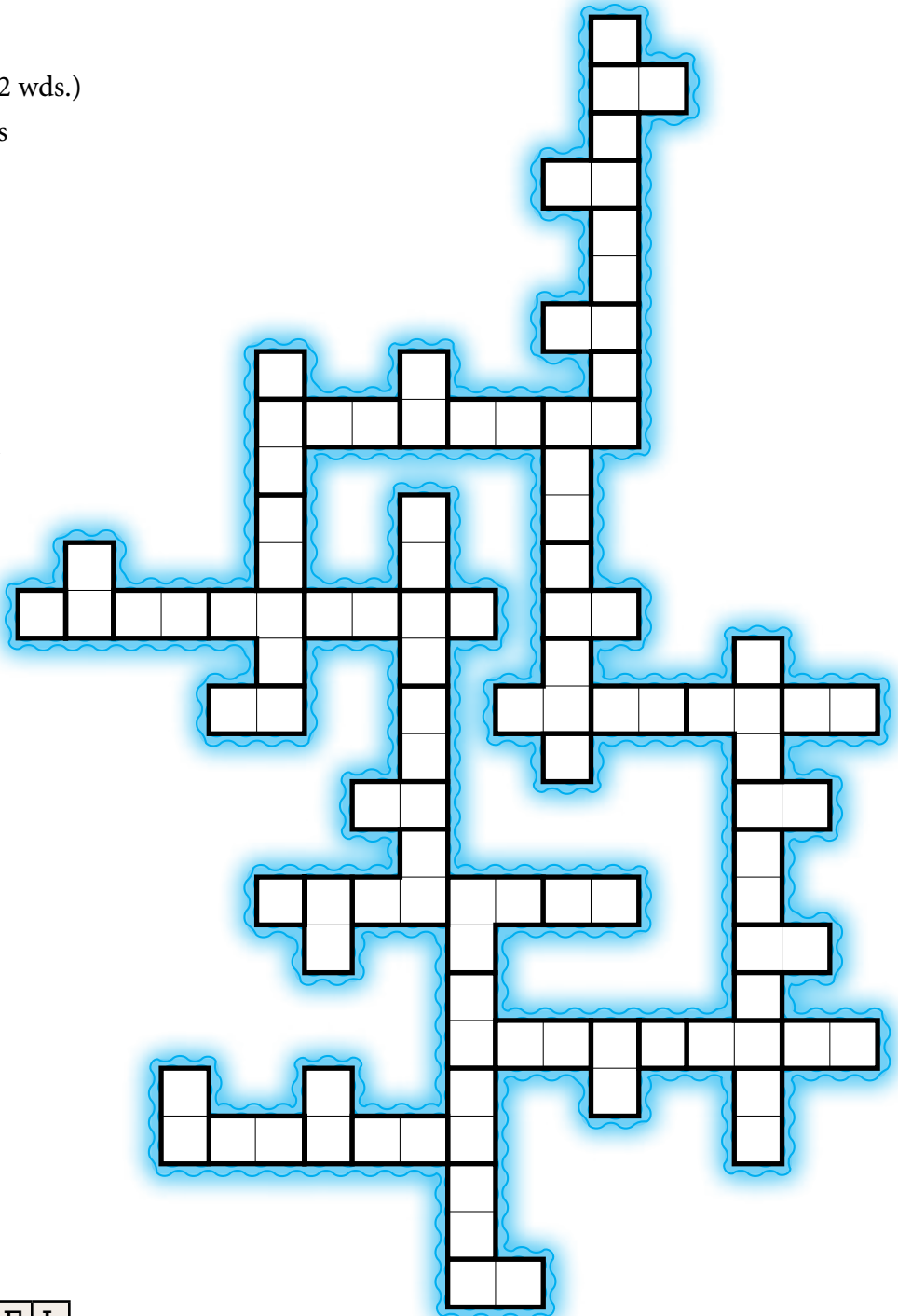

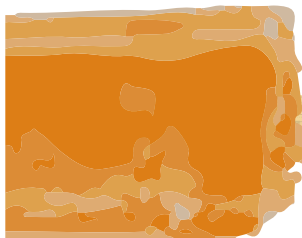


Popsicle Break

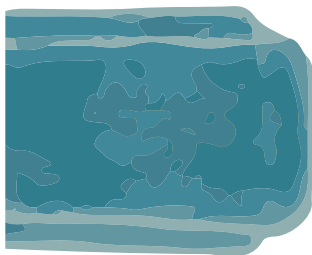

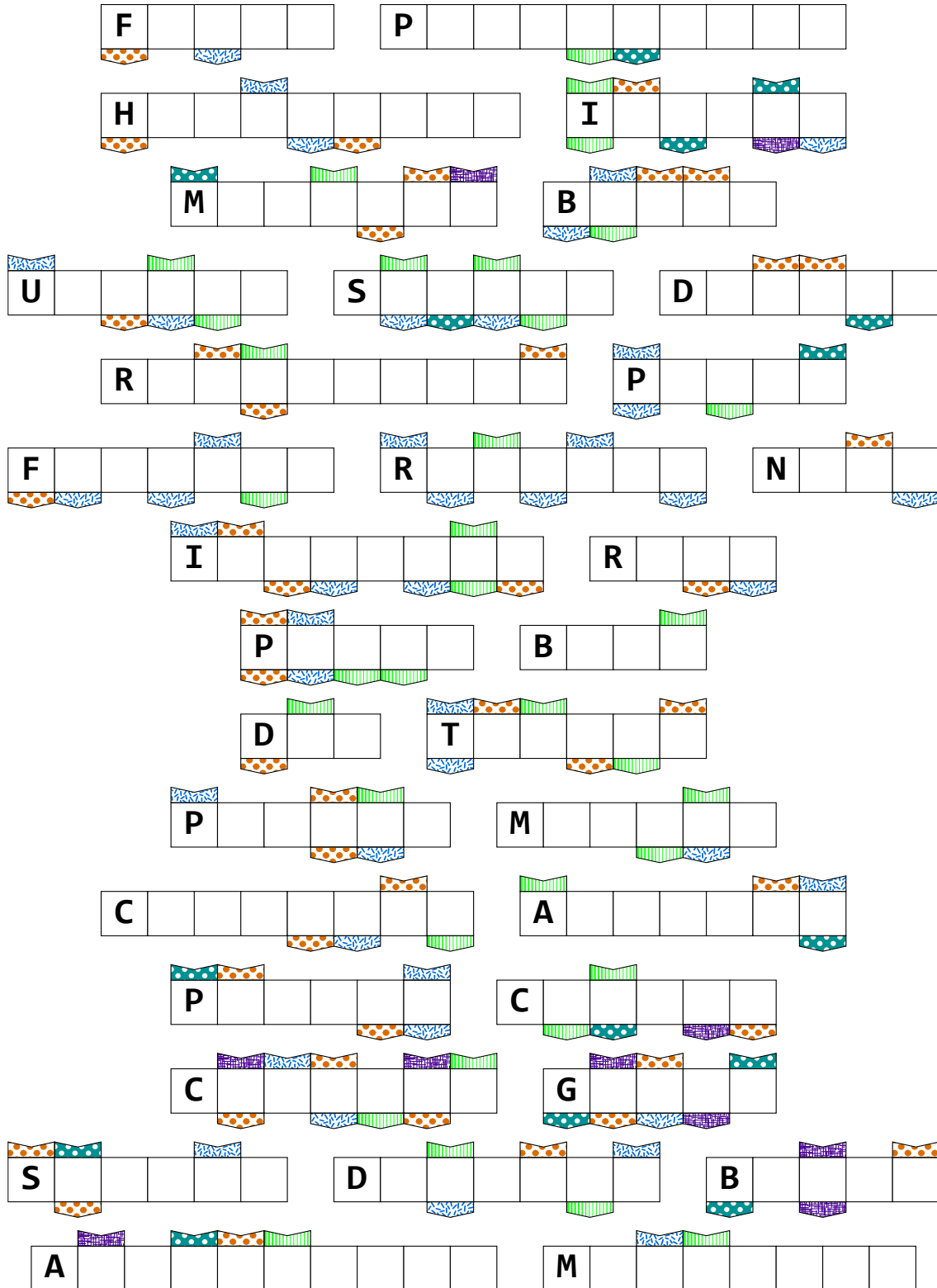
Cryptocurrencies

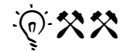
